Is this what we want for our neighbourhood?

Abe Salloum (owner of Tony's Pizza) has acquired seven properties on Cunard St, Robie St, and Compton Av. He wants to demolish the buildings and erect an eight-storey apartment block, with its parking garage entrance in the Compton Avenue neighbourhood. A building with this height, density, multi-unit use, and commercial use (the same as The Keep, under construction at Quinpool and Vernon) is not permitted here, so he and his architect W.M. Fares have asked city hall to change municipal regulations so that this building can proceed.
